RESOLVING THE FEDERAL CONFLICT

Dear Director Colón,

I am writing to you about the conflict between the federal regulation of marijuana and the state-authorized use of cannabis in Hawaii that is causing disastrous consequences for our medical cannabis patients and dispensaries.

I see from DCCA's previous <u>news release</u>, that this is an issue your department is also trying to resolve.

I would like to propose a solution for this conflict, which involves obtaining a federal exemption from the DEA for the state-authorized use of cannabis in Hawaii. I believe this is a viable solution that the State can act upon to resolve a conflict that it created in the first place when it authorized the use of cannabis for specific purposes under part IX of Chapter 329, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

The lowa Department of Public Health is currently preparing a federal exemption application for their program to prevent the loss of federal funding at schools and long-term care facilities where the state-authorized use of cannabis is occurring.

I am proposing an amendment to Hawaii's Medical Use of Cannabis Act that would support similar action here. Attached for your consideration.
